SUBJECT: Implementation of the ATA Carnet System in Peru

DATE: 12 February 2024

Dear Colleague,

From 30 April 2024, the Lima Chamber of Commerce and Industry will become the 79th guaranteeing organisation member of the ICC WCF/ATA international guarantee chain.

- ATA Carnets will be accepted by the Peruvian Customs for the following categories of goods: goods for display or use at **exhibitions**, **fairs**, **meetings**, or similar events and **professional equipment**
- ATA Carnets are accepted for transit
- ATA Carnets are accepted for postal traffic (procedure to be advised!)
- ATA Carnets are accepted for both hand-carried goods and freight
- Importation in multiple / split consignments is accepted

Languages in which Carnets should be completed

English or Spanish. Peruvian Customs may require translation when Carnets are completed in any other language.

Special Notes

In case of incorrect goods valuation, the ATA Carnet shall be rejected at the time of import. In case the claim is regularised by evidence other than the re-exportation counterfoil completed and stamped by the Peruvian Customs authority, Peru Customs reserves the right to charge a regularisation fee (the amount is to be confirmed).

Replacement Carnets

Accepted in accordance with Article 14 of Annex A to the Istanbul Convention.
